About Our Program

General Information

Ages: Children ages 5-11.

Location: 10 Church St Westford, MA.

We are near the heart of town, about 5 minutes from 495 and less than 5 minutes from the Westford Common.

Hours: 7am-6pm daily. No additional fees are charged for this extended day schedule.

Experienced and Caring Staff

We take pride in our exceptional staff, many of whom have extensive child care experience and have been working at the Kids' League many years. As a staff, we highly value each child. We strive to give them the outstanding and nurturing care that they deserve as individuals. The Kids' League is fully licensed by the state of Massachusetts.

Weekly Themes

Each week's activities are generally structured around our weekly theme. These activities are chosen with each age group in mind. The weekly themes allow campers to explore

different areas through hands-on activities, related crafts, and fun, yet educational presentations.

Daily Clubs

Each day, the children can choose 2 clubs to join for the day. The activities within these clubs change every day, always giving campers a unique experience whether they choose to repeat a club or choose a mix of clubs throughout the week. Clubs are customized to the children's ages and are designed to both challenge and enrich each child.

Age Groups

The children are divided into 2 age groups: 5-7 year olds with their home base on the Second floor of our facility, and 8-11 year olds on the Lower Level. While the weekly themes and the clubs are the same for both age groups, the activities within each group are customized to challenge and engage each age group appropriately.

Weekly Beach Trips to Forge Village Pond

Once each week, campers have some fun in the sun at Forge Village Pond. There is opportunity for swimming, sand castles, beachball volley ball and hiking. To ensure safety, we hire Town of Westford life guards as well as use a buddy system. These beach trips are a favorite!

Regular Field Trips & Special Guests

Weekly field trips or special guests are chosen to compliment the weekly theme. On all field trips, campers are placed in small, age-appropriate teams. While having fun and learning, **safety is our top priority.**
